Fortythree women and 57 men who have completed their treatment at Mental Health Centre (MHC), Peroorkada, and have shown an improvement in their condition have not been taken back by their families, the Director of Health Services has informed Kerala State Human Rights Commission. Of them, 24 women and 42 men are from other states, a report from DHS V. Meenakshi said.

Commission chairperson Antony Dominic directed that those not accepted by their families be shifted to government-designated rehabilitation centres. Dominic has visited the MHC on November 17 last and given directions to the government. Following this, the DHS convened a meeting to discuss the implementation of rehabilitation centres for the welfare of those people who have been cured of their mental ailments.

A modern psychiatric and forensic wards will be constructed at a cost of Rs. 5.6 crore at MHC. A new outpatient block will also be established. The number of employees will be enhanced and the cooking duty will be given to Kudumbashree, Dominic's report said.
